- 1. It begins with a directive: an official authoritative instruction.
  - A. To love sincerely and to be committed to doing good. Philippians 2:3-4; John 13:34-35
  - B. It's important not to be a hypocrite. Matthew 6:1-4
  - C. You are to fervently serve the Lord. Titus 2:11-14; Colossians 3:23-24
- 2. It is founded on an attitude of humility.
- 3. And it comes with a warning on how to treat those outside the church, including our enemies.
  - A. Never take revenge in your own hands. Matthew 5:39-45
  - B. Keep peace with others if it all possible.
  - C. Our kindness can possibly lead to eternal repentance. Proverbs 25:21-22; Romans 2:4

- 1. Ask forgiveness when you know you are being a hypocrite.
- 2. Give preference to others by seeing the best in people, especially to those outside your denomination.
